Andre, Morris & Buttery Law Firm Finds North County History a Powerful Draw
New Paso location showcases firm's commitment to past & future

Paso Robles, CA – When longtime local law firm Andre, Morris & Buttery needed larger space for its North County office, it made perfect sense for the firm to find a historic location in downtown Paso Robles. The Central Coast's 60-year old law firm chose a beautiful two-story building at 1337 Vine Street in Paso Robles' prized historic district. The home was originally built 120 years earlier by local merchant Herman Eppinger and has been beautifully restored by residents Bruce and Terry White.

The home offers a number of interesting parallels to the AMB firm. After many years and numerous residents, the home was purchased in 1975 by Paso Robles native son Daniel Lewis and his wife Louise. Lewis educated Paso Robles seventh-graders in a teaching career that covered 25 years and led to a school being named after him. AMB principal Michael Morris, a SLO County resident for 60 years, served on the San Luis Coastal School Board and was honored for his civic contributions when he was named SLO Citizen of the Year in 2004. Michael's son Kevin is a second generation principal at the firm, joining a group of 15 attorneys practicing in a range of business law specialties.

Jean St. Martin, AMB partner and North County resident, helped lead the relocation and said the move to the Vine Street location was ideal. "We have seen tremendous growth in our North County client base," St. Martin said, "and the move will help us continue our service. We are excited to be in a location that is convenient to the new Paso Robles courthouse, historically significant, absolutely charming and equipped with the latest technology," she said.

St. Martin is keeping the firm's tradition of community service alive. She serves as president of the Paso Robles Children's Museum and is an active member of Rotary. She is joined in the Paso Robles office by longtime AMB principal, Dennis Law, who has moved his office to the new Paso Robles location.

Andre, Morris & Buttery has offices in San Luis Obispo and Santa Maria in addition to its Paso Robles location. The beautifully restored building at 1337 Vine Street is located just off the corner of 13th Street and Vine, a block from Paso Robles' downtown center.
